Educational Requirements **Note: Education requirements no longer in effect. None required.**

Prospective Members must demonstrate that they have passed a USPS or NASBLA "approved" boating course. This certification can be provided in one of the following ways:

- 1) Certificate of completion from a local USPS Boating Course
- 2) Certificate of completion from Approved Equivalent Boating Course such as the USPS Boat Smart, ABC, USCG Aux Course, USCG Captain License, etc. (In Japan, either the Class 1 or 2 Japanese boating license.)

Membership Qualifications:

- To qualify for active membership in the United States Power Squadrons, you must:
- Be able and Willing to Contribute Time, Energy and Skills to the Objectives of USPS
 - Pass An Exam Approved By The Operating Committee
 - Be Accepted By The Squadron Executive Committee
 - Be At Least 18 Years of Age
 - Have Paid All Applicable Entrance Fees and Dues
